

## Child and Vulnerable Persons Mission Statement of the OLD SILHILLIANS' RIFLE CLUB (OSRC) adopted on the 13th day of February 2014

The aim of the club is to ensure the enjoyment of all members regardless of age, gender, race or ability in shooting in a safe and controlled environment. All members will be treated with respect.

No member will be intimidated or abused due to age, gender, race or ability.

Every member will:

- ensure the safety of all other members by following the guidelines laid down by the National Smallbore Rifle Association
- ensure that the welfare of all the members is paramount
- ensure fair play among all members
- ensure that the coaching methods of members is appropriate and will be discussed with the trainee first. The coaching of junior members will be discussed with and approved by the trainee's parent/guardian before training starts.
- be encouraged to take part in the decision-making with regard to club matters.

If any member, either junior or adult, has any concern that they or others are not being treated, as they should under the guidelines mentioned above then they must inform the CPO (vulnerable adults and child protection officer). The matter will be dealt with in confidence in accordance with the NSRA rules.
